- **Saturday, July 17th**, the Market will have its **Grand Opening** celebrating our new Pavilion. Come join us in the celebration.

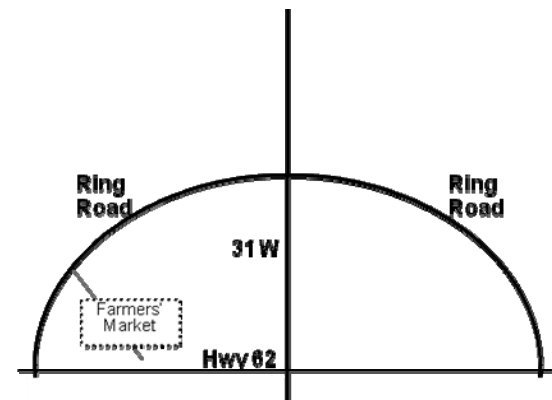
